TOUR ITINERARY



DAY 01: DEPART USA

Today you can make your way to the airport for your flight to Cape Town, South Africa. Overnight flight

DAY 02: ARRIVE CAPE TOWN

On arrival in **Cape Town** today you will be met by our company representative, who will escort you to your hotel in the city. Cape Town is undoubtedly one of the most beautiful cities in the world. Situated amidst majestic mountains and surrounded by pristine white beaches, it is home to a rich cultural and historical heritage, vibrant restaurants and nightlife and a multitude of activities. Overnight in Cape Town.

DAY 03: CAPE TOWN

Today enjoy a **half day city tour** of Cape Town. Visit the **Castle of Good Hope**, a pentagonal fortification built by the Dutch in 1666, and the **South African Museum**. You will also visit **Table Mountain** (weather permitting) where you can enjoy some magnificent views of the city. The steep cliffs and rocky outcrops of the mountain play home to approximately 1470 species of plants and a stunning range of fauna, including the Table Mountain Ghost Frog. This **afternoon is free** for you to spend at leisure. Dinner at **Gold Restaurant**, where you can enjoy an interactive drumming session. Overnight in Cape Town (B, D)

DAY 04: CAPE TOWN

Today you can enjoy a **Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour**. Travel via the 12 Apostles, Hout Bay and Chapman's Peak (dependant on the road being open) - one of the region's most dramatic mountain drives. You will visit the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve**, established in 1939 to protect indigenous flora and fauna. You can take the **funicular** to the vantage point to see the "meeting of the two oceans" at the point of the Cape. Afterwards continue to **Simon's Town**, where you will enjoy lunch, before travelling to the historical **Constantia Winelands**, where you will visit the Groot Constantia Wine estate and enjoy a relaxing wine tasting. The day will end with a short visit to the **Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens** on the eastern slopes of Table Mountain. Afterwards return to the hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Cape Town (B, L)

DAY 05: CAPE TOWN - FRANSCHHOEK

Today you will travel to the Cape Winelands for a **full day Winelands Tour**. Visit **Stellenbosch**, which is known worldwide for its quality wines and spectacular beauty, before travelling up the beautiful Hels Hoogte pass to **Boschendal Wine Estate** to sample some of the local wines and enjoy a delicious lunch. Afterwards you can enjoy a **Wine and Cheese Tasting** before continuing your journey to **Franschhoek**, the 'Gourmet Capital', which is surrounded by majestic mountains. Overnight in Franschhoek (B, L)

DAY 06: CAPE TOWN - JOHANNESBURG - THE GREATER KRUGER AREA (FLIGHT)

Transfer to the airport for the short flight to **Johannesburg**. Upon arrival in Johannesburg you will be met by our company representative and transferred to Bongani Mountain Lodge, situated next to the **Kruger National Park**. The Kruger National Park / Greater Kruger Region is a premier game sanctuary that covers more than 20,000 square kilometres of land. It boasts the greatest species diversity in Africa - more than 140

resident mammal species, including the Big Five (lion, elephant, leopard, buffalo and rhino). Dinner and Overnight in Kruger (B, D)

DAY 07 (FRIDAY): GREATER KRUGER AREA

Today you may enjoy an **Early Morning Game Drive**. The possibility of viewing the big 5 up close makes this an unforgettable experience as experienced rangers and trackers share their knowledge of the African bush. After breakfast you can spend the rest of the **morning free at leisure**. Lunch will be served at around 13h00. This afternoon you can enjoy an **Afternoon Game Drive**. After tracking the big 5 enjoy a sundowner and the chance to see the small but very important local nocturnal animals. Weather permitting you will enjoy a **boma (bush) dinner** this evening. Overnight in Kruger (B, L, D)

DAY 08: GREATER KRUGER AREA - JOHANNESBURG

Today you opt to do an **optional Early Morning Game Drive**. After breakfast you will be transferred back to **Johannesburg**, where you can check into your hotel situated just outside the city. Tonight dinner will be enjoyed at the **Carnivore Restaurant** near your hotel. Situated in natural surroundings overlooking the Krugersdorp hills, the restaurant serves many different types of meat including pork, lamb, beef, chicken, ribs and sausages, not to mention game meats such as crocodile, zebra, giraffe, impala and ostrich. Overnight in Johannesburg (B, D)

DAY 09: JOHANNESBURG - VICTORIA FALLS (FLIGHT)

Today you will be transferred to the airport for a flight to **Victoria Falls**. Upon arrival at Victoria Falls you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. After some time for relaxation you can enjoy a **cruise on the mighty Zambezi River**. You may be lucky enough to see a variety of game in their natural environment, including hippo, crocodile, elephant and sometimes even rhino, as well as many different bird species. There are also great photo opportunities against often-spectacular African sunsets. Afterwards you will return to the hotel where dinner will be served. Overnight in Victoria Falls (B, D)

DAY 10: VICTORIA FALLS

Today enjoy a **guided tour of Victoria Falls**. En-route you may stop at the '**Big Tree**' to take some photos. Today you will be accompanied through the Rainforest by a qualified naturalist guide who will give a brief history of the Falls themselves as well as detailing the flora, fauna, birds, wildlife and other points of interest. Raincoats will be provided when needed. The rest of the **afternoon will be at leisure** to relax at the hotel. Later this evening you will be transferred to the award winning African Boma restaurant for a **traditional African feast** and a colourful and energetic display of local songs and dances by Ndebele performers. Overnight at Victoria Falls (B, D)

DAY 11: VICTORIA FALLS AND DEPART (FLIGHT)

After breakfast today you will be transferred by road to Victoria Falls Airport for a flight to Johannesburg. On arrival in Johannesburg you will connect with your international flight home. Overnight flight (B)

DAY 12: ARRIVE USA

Early this evening you will arrive back in the USA.
