



Teacher Extern Video Submission Information

Create and upload a short video introducing yourself and your interest in the Teacher Externship Program. Please follow all instructions below. *Note that video submission is an optional step in the application process.*

Instructions for video submission:

- Your video should be no longer than 4 minutes
- Use landscape format, not portrait if using a phone to record (phone sideways, not vertical)
- Briefly introduce yourself (name, school, school district county/city, grades taught) before beginning your question responses
- Upload your video to YouTube and set the visibility to unlisted (see link below for additional help)
- Click on share and copy the link to your unlisted video and paste it into the correct field on your Teacher Externship Application online form.
 - If you record the video after you have submitted your application, you may email the link to your video to mdchamber@mdchamber.org with the subject “MD Teacher Externship Video Submission”. Make sure to include your full name and school in the email.
- Video submissions are due no later than **January 2, 2023**.

1. Tell us who you are.
2. What subjects do you teach and why are you passionate about teaching?
3. Why are you interested in the Maryland Chamber Foundation Teacher Externship Program?
4. How will you leverage the Teacher Externship experience in your classroom to inspire your students?
5. Tell us any specifics about your school's student population relating to how they might benefit from your participation in this program.

Please present your authentic self and address the requested elements. Application evaluators will use the video to get to know you, your passion and your interest in the Teacher Externship Program. We will not evaluate the production value of the video you submitted.
